### **OUTDOOR**

Board members discussed the approved tournament schedule for 2007. Additional information on each tournament (e.g., time limits, weigh-in locations, etc.) will be made available to club members on the website and in future newsletters as the tournaments draw near. The following changes/updates were discussed for a few of the tournaments:
