<p>Tom Ganetis reported that, as of right now and beginning October 1, 2009, all anglers who wish to fish in the marine and coastal district or to fish in other state waters for "migratory fish from the sea" (such as striped bass, American shad, hickory shad, blueback herring, alewife) must have a recreational marine fishing license. The new Recreational Marine Fishing License will be available for purchase on the Internet or from NYS hunting and fishing license vendors soon.</p> <p>Party and charter vessel owners or operators must also possess a recreational marine fishing</p>


TREASURER'S REPORT
