

## SURF TOURNAMENTS



Just in case you have not noticed we have not had too many nice weekends as of late. The October 26-27 tournament was blown out and rescheduled for the following weekend. Luckily, some quality fish were caught some time between November 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>. At least six (6) members fished the tournament and the following are the final results:

## BLACKFISH TOURNAMENT

Time:	7:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. ( <i>Boat will leave the dock at 7:00 a.m.</i> )
Cost:	\$75 per person including a 15% tip for mate (Assuming 15 people go)

Joel reports that approximately 15 people are signed up so far. The boat fishes 20 people very comfortably. With that in mind, the cut off for the tournament will be 20 (first come, first serve). Of course, if we end up with a couple of extra in the end that should be O.K. with the captain. Now, as far as cancellations are concerned.....normally the club cancels a boat tournament when there are small craft warnings but in this case, the captain may not necessarily cancel because they feel they can "tuck" themselves in a spot away from the wind. So, to avoid any issues, if there is a small craft warning the morning of December 1<sup>st</sup> the tournament will be cancelled **but the charter will still be on**. If the weather really looks bad and you don't want to make the trip out to Orient Point to find out the charter is cancelled give Joel Fumuso a call at 821-8084 the night before the trip. Joel should know after 6:00 p.m. if the trip is on or off.
