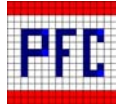

RECIPE CORNER



Bluefish Our Way

4-6 fillets bluefish, red meat trimmed and cut into "fingers"
1c bread crumbs
1c Panko flakes
1/4c grated Romano cheese
1 egg, beaten
1/4c butter (1/2 stick)
2tbs olive oil

Melt 1tbs butter and 1tbs olive oil in frying pan
Trim bluefish fillets and cut into "fingers"
Beat egg with a splash of water.
Mix Panko, Breadcrumbs and Romano cheese together.
Dip fish in egg and roll in crumbs until well coated.
Fry until golden brown on both sides.
Keep in warm oven until ready to serve.

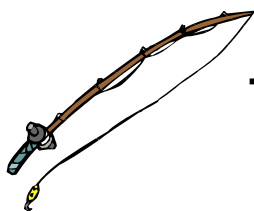

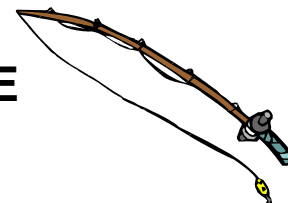
